When packing for your stay at the Home of Grace please be aware that there is limited storage space. You may bring ten (10) outfits, including your church clothes. Any more than this will be returned to your family or put in our clothes closet. If your family brings any clothing items to you during your stay, you must send back an equal number of items with them.

Cigarettes (if you smoke)

Toiletries: shampoo, deodorant, toothpaste/toothbrush, disposable razors, soap, lotion, non-alcohol mouthwash. Also 2 towels/2 washcloths

Hair Products: blow-dryer, curling iron, pump hairspray (no aerosol) etc.

Make-up (if you choose to wear it)

NO PERFUME

Personal Hygiene items (three monthly cycles)

Casual Clothing:

Shirts must be modest no mid-drifts or suggestive messages on shirts.

Jeans, Slacks, Capri's, no tight fitting pants.No shorts

Dresses must be knee length and no strapless or spaghetti straps.

Tennis shoes and or sandals

Sunday dress: either a dress or nice pants suit only, and shoes appropriate for church.

Night clothes, bed pillow (if you desire)

Envelopes, stationary, stamps (you may write and receive letters upon your arrival).

Highlighters/ loose leaf paper/small flashlight

Phone card if your family is long distance.

Bible, AA and/or NA book if you have one if not one will be assigned to you. No other reading material accepted.

CD Player with headphones, No Radio, AA batteries

(1) case of bottled water (1) bag of hard candy (no gum) (1) bag of chocolate candy. All other snacks and drinks must be purchased from vending machines on campus.

Money for snacks and Soda's will be kept in Housemothers safe, \$5.00 a day will be given out by housemother if needed. **We cannot cash checks or money orders.**

NO RADIOS, CELL PHONES, BEEPERS, BOOKS, MAGAZINES, GAMES, PERSONAL VEHICLES MAY NOT BE LEFT ON CAMPUS.

Medical/Dental:

All preexisting medical or dental matters must be taken care of or postponed prior to enrollment. If medical, dental or psychological conditions occur during the client's recovery and cannot be taken care of on campus, the client will be asked to postpone treatment until completion of program. A volunteer medical clinic is available for minor ailments.

Legal Obligations:

Court dates must be postponed prior to admission. Applicants entering the program without notifying the court or probation officer in advance may be disqualified and make to leave the program. If a client leaves the program or is dismissed the court and or probations officer will be notified upon their departure.
